Serving with the Intergalactic Organization or IGO, Delta Team Chief of Security Sergeant Darryl Snow is a career soldier, but of late the loneliness of his job has started weighing on him. Holographic sex is no longer fulfilling his needs. He wants what most men end up wanting at one time or another in their lives – a wife. A real, flesh and blood woman he can love and who loves him back, despite his scarred face and body. When he's assigned to pick up a scientist from the Mars moon of Europa and escort her back to headquarters at Mars Outpost 1 for questioning in the murders of her fellow scientists, he didn't count on falling in love with her. For the past five years, Dr. Cricket Moore has been assigned to the Io Outpost Research and Development Center. Until all her fellow scientists unexplainably ended up dead and she was taken into custody for questioning, she was part of the Ganor Project researching Europa's volcanoes. Whoever killed them had also stolen all their research data, and now they want her dead as well. And if that isn't bad enough, it's looking like the IGO is going to pin the murders and theft on her. The only one who thought she was innocent is the man assigned to bring her in – a man whose touch ignites a sexual fire in her that threatens to burn out of control. Darryl falls hard and fast for the saucy, plucky Cricket, something he knows is going to complicate both his job and his life. With danger to her imminent and lust for the ebony-skinned beauty consuming him, will he be able to maintain his professional conduct toward her and keep her safe? Or once again, as it happened to him in the past, will his raging desire for a woman be his downfall? And hers? Sudden Snow by RaeLynn Blue is a sizzling hot, high-octane read that doesn't let you put it down until the very last page is turned. The author did a superb job of blending elements of danger, suspense and mystery with strong, appealing characters and seriously hot sex to write one of the best sci-fi/action-adventure romances I've read in quite some time.
