As a profiler, he enables business deals by making sure that the round pegs of one side of the deal fit into the opposing party's square holes. When between contracts, depression and panic are likely to creep in, especially now as he's been notified that his abusive parent is dying in the hospital. So he welcomes the new contract, a quest to acquire an artifact from a businessman who is also the owner of an art gallery and a patron of native artists. Kieran is not prepared for Joshua's overt interest from the first sight, nor Joshua's precognitive statement that he and Kieran will meet again.
